A Message for our Sandpoint Neighbors



Solid Ground is pleased to announce that Santos Place, our transitional housing program at 6940 62nd Ave. NE in Magnuson Park, is getting a facelift! This property was renovated for use as transitional housing in 1999, but the building was not insulated, and siding, roof and windows have all aged and are in need of replacement.

Starting this month, we will be replacing the siding, roof and windows and making other repairs. The project will bring the building closer to its original appearance as a naval dormitory, as well as making the building more energy efficient. The project is being funded by the State of Washington, City of Seattle and Solid Ground. The work has been approved by the Seattle Landmarks Preservation Board.
